The most common characteristics include substantial difficulties in social interaction and communication, as well as unusual and aberrant behaviour.

Autism Spectrum Disorder is a lifelong disability that is present from birth. Individuals with autism spectrum disorder have trouble interpreting, sorting through, and integrating sensory information. This often results in hypersensitivity to sound, light and to be touched.

Individuals with autism also have trouble processing and interpreting information in order to grasp the meaning and context of their experiences. They also have trouble understanding and identifying with other people's thoughts, feelings and needs.
